

## **Applying Body Language During Interview: Capturing Right Candidates**

### **Introduction**

Hiring the right talent is one of the most important decisions for any organisation, yet many interviewers rely only on spoken answers and traditional evaluation methods. Candidates today are more prepared with rehearsed responses, online coaching, and scripted strategies that often mask their true personality or capability. Relying solely on verbal answers can therefore lead to poor hiring decisions. What often makes the difference is *body language*. Nonverbal communication—such as posture, eye contact, facial expressions, hand gestures, and even micro-movements—reveals hidden attitudes, confidence levels, and honesty. By learning how to interpret these subtle signals, interviewers can gain deeper insights into a candidate's real character, mindset, and potential fit for the organisation. This program is designed to equip participants with practical tools to apply body language analysis during interviews. Participants will learn how to read nonverbal cues, cross-check them against verbal responses, and use this knowledge to ask more targeted follow-up questions. By the end of the session, interviewers will be able to conduct interviews with greater accuracy, ensuring that the right candidates are selected—not just the ones with polished answers.
