Time	Topics
9:00am – 10:30am	<p>The Stone in David Slingshot</p> <p>This module starts to look at the turbulence rising, risky business, the upside of turbulence.</p>
10:30am– 11:00am	Tea Break and Networking
11:00am – 1:00pm	<p>Time, Timing and Luck</p> <p>After identifying the turbulence, this module helps the participants look at the backward-L view of time, the inverse power law of opportunities, perfect timing, and the luck of the draw.</p>
1:00pm – 2:00pm	Lunch and Networking
2:00pm – 3:30pm	<p>The Map Paradox</p> <p>In this module, the participants would be exposed to construct mental maps. The module also covers topics such as question Marx, provisional knowledge in the real world and what popper missed.</p>
3:30pm – 4:00pm	Tea Break and Networking
4:00pm- 5:00pm	<p>Active Inertia and Mind the Gap</p> <p>The participants would learn the in escape commitments, reinforce commitments, and active inertia from the map paradox. From there, the practical session is conducted to map the gaps. The participants would start to learn to take care of common anomalies and anomaly pitfalls. Participants would identify that they got wrong fast in this module.</p>

Time	Topics
9:00am – 10:30am	<p>Keep the Map Fluid</p> <p>This module gives opportunities to participants to discover more opportunities that are needed in facing turbulence. The improvisation teams are needed to support and provide rush data for decision-making. Besides, continuous interaction and transparency ensure everyone knows the health of the organisation. Everyone must participate in the whole operation rather than work in a silo. However, we must make the working environment safe so that employees would have the confidence to share the workplace's real situation.</p>
10:30am– 11:00am	Tea Break and Networking
11:00am – 1:00pm	<p>The Essence of Agility and the Agility Loop</p> <p>The topic includes winning through agility, type of agility, from lines to loops, and the agility loop. The participants would conduct a discussion to make sense, discuss making a choice and discussion about making it happen, and discuss making revisions.</p>

1:00pm – 2:00pm	Lunch and Networking
2:00pm – 3:30pm	<p>Building an Agile Organisation and Avoiding a Corporate Midlife Crisis</p> <p>This module gets participants to understand how to win by agility, how to get and apply rush data. The participants would learn how to apply cohort Vikings to create a culture of agility. We prepare the participants to be agile leaders before requesting the organisation to be agile. The participants would learn the stages of agility in the organisation to overcome pitfalls and crises during each stage of the culture change.</p>
